Jose Pond Pitch

June 14th, July 12th and August 9th @ 4 PM in the Pavilion

Format

Each person will be randomly made into a team.

Example if 36 people show there will be 6 tables of 6 people

(6 random people will play as 2 teams of 3 people)

if 40 people show there will be 5 tables of 8 people

(8 random people will play as 2 teams of 4 people)

The randomly selected teams will play 2 rounds of Pitch. 4 hands per round starting at 16 and counting down with a possible low score of 0.

After 2 rounds any 4 people from the table will randomly move to another table. Everyone should sit so they do not have the same partners. The 4 people who stay at the table should sit so they are also not on the same team as they were.

The newly selected teams will play another 2 rounds of Pitch.

After 2 rounds any 4 people will randomly move to another table. Everyone should sit so they do not have the same partners. The 4 people who stay at the table should sit so they are also not on the same team as they were.

The newly selected teams will play another 2 rounds of Pitch.

Pitch will conclude at the end of 2 rounds of pitch being played 3 times.

This may seem a little confusing but I can assure you it is not.

Every person will keep track of their own score.

The person with the lowest score after 3 months will win 50% of the pot. The other 50% will be payed to the JPA. Cost to play will be \$5 per person.

Game rules

You must deal clockwise

You must deal 3 cards at a time
